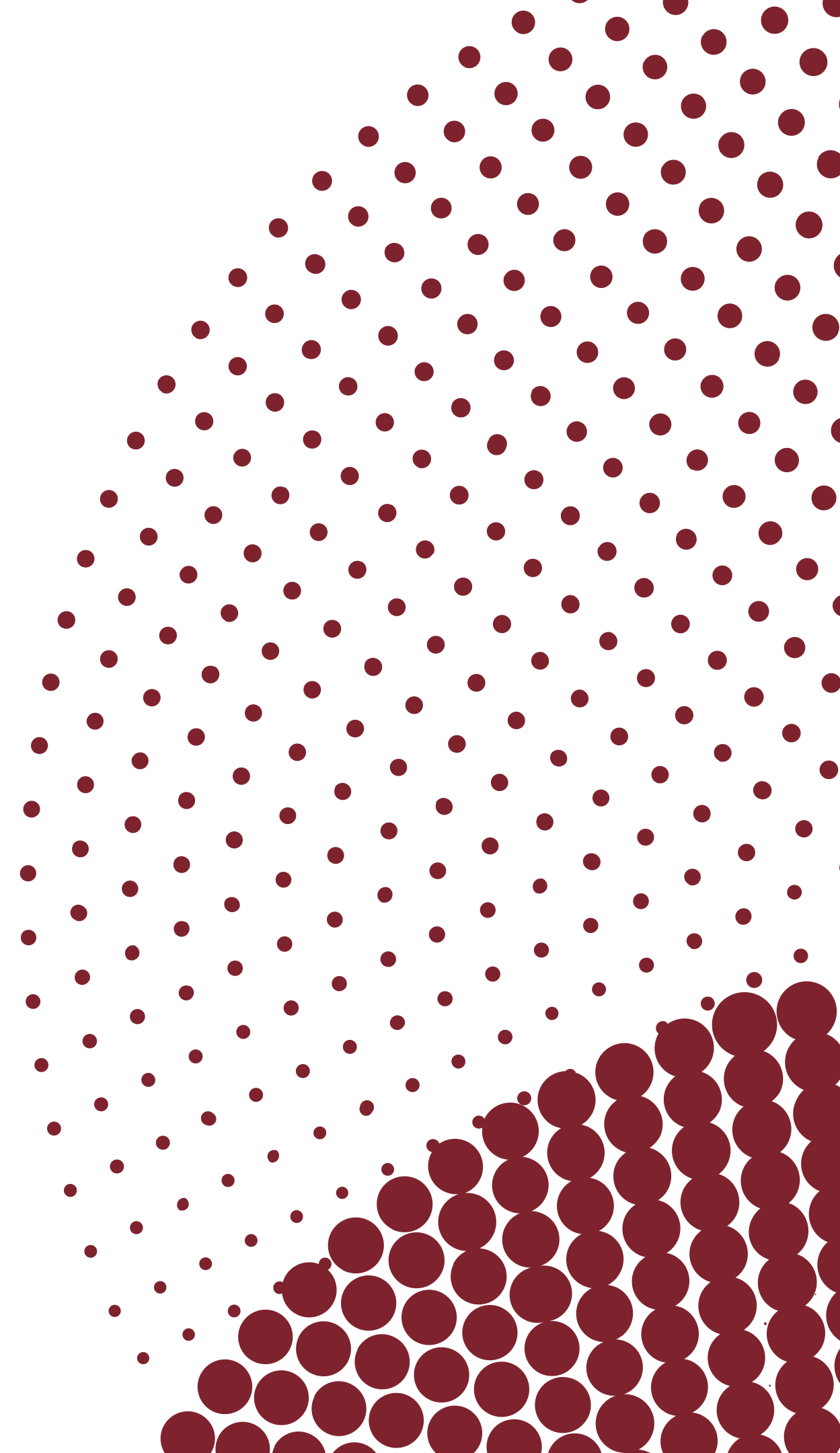

Vision

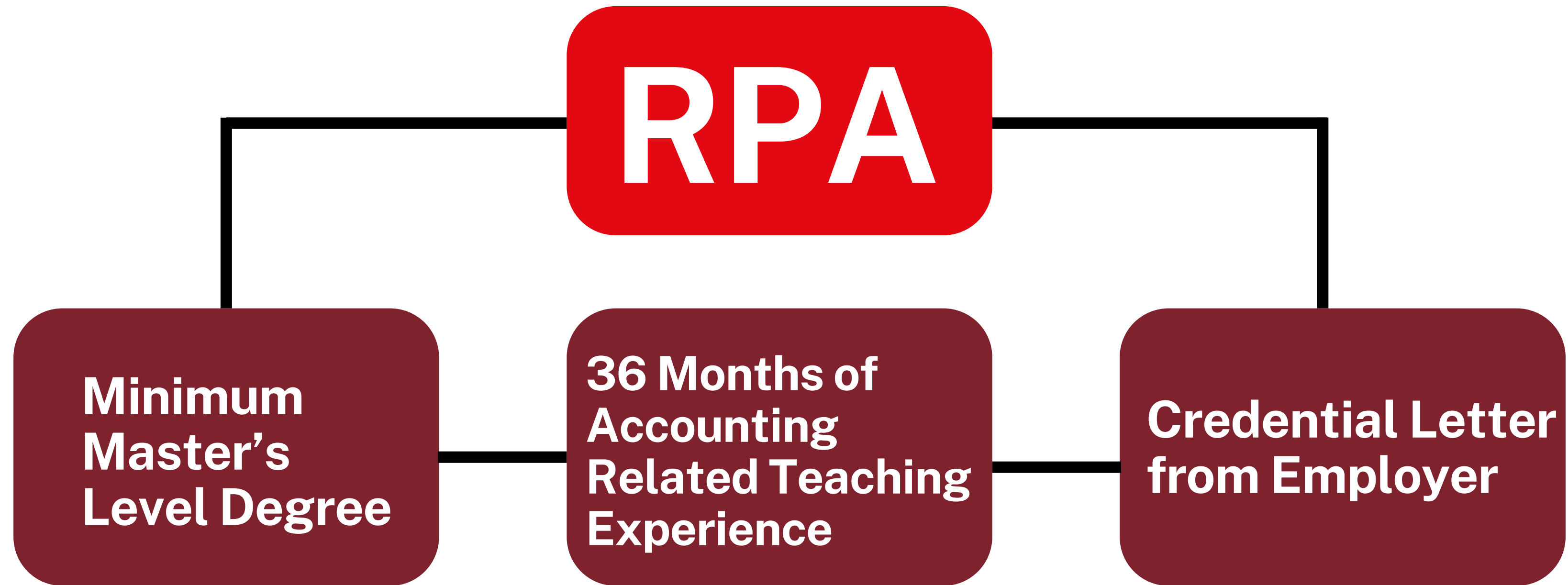
